On October 4, a parent followed the guidance [on the FCPS website](#) (Meals tab on the homepage; seen right), which says that Nutritional Analysis Reports are available in the Food Service Office -- and actually drove to the food service office, located at 33 Thomas Johnson Drive (off Hayward Rd), and requested nutritional analysis reports.

The new Food Service Manager, Judith Gordon, spoke with this parent and **refused to provide any reports** and further instructed the parent to go **issue a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request** for those reports with FCPS Legal Services.

**▶▶ FCPS says nutritional information is available, and when asked, FCPS will tell you NO and to "Go FOIA". Just more FCPS 'truthiness' -- pretending and claiming to be "transparent", and in reality, just the opposite is the truth.**
